Pre-Registration for 2009-2010 School Year

Counselors will begin working with students starting February 9 in their English classes to complete the pre-registration process for next school year. Students should choose their classes carefully, as their selections affect our planning.

Summer School Registration in April

Students who are interested in summer school need to be aware that we are considering the possibility of operating the summer session from June 29 - July 29 this year.

Important AIMS Information

There has been some confusion about who is required to take the AIMS tests.

To clarify:

- Any student who is in his or her *second* academic year of high school is **required** to take the AIMS tests.

Example: A student who is a second-year freshman is required to test.

- Any student in his or her third or more year of high school who has not met or exceeded the standard is **required** to take the AIMS tests whose standards have not been met or exceeded.

Example: A student who has met the standard for reading, but not writing, is required to take the writing test.

- A student who has already met the standard **may choose** to retest to try and exceed the standard.

Meeting or exceeding the standard on the reading, writing, and mathematics tests is a requirement for high school graduation. Students cannot be issued a standard Arizona high school diploma without passing these tests.

AIMS Bus Routes

Students who need to take the AIMS test ride the buses at the regular times.

Students who do not need to take the AIMS test ride the buses two hours later.

This second bus run will not go out to Dolan Springs, Wikieup, or Yucca. Those students will need to ride the bus at the regular times. Students in the Truxton area can catch the second bus run beginning at Antares Road.
