**Arizona State Tax Credit
ARS 43-1089.01**

Dear Families & Friends,

The Arizona State Legislature has passed a tax law that enables you to receive a tax credit for making a donation to your local schools. As a resident of Arizona, an individual may contribute from \$10 up to \$200 to a school activity, and married couples filing jointly may contribute up to \$400. This contribution is deducted from the amount of taxes owed or returned back to you on your tax refund. Essentially, this donation is free money which benefits a child's education and school experiences.

I encourage you to make a tax credit contribution this year to a Kingman Unified School District school. With such a vast number of activities district-wide and challenging financial times, it is difficult to keep pace with expenses and technological advances. In the past, tax credit donations assisted students in competition and travel expenses, provided additional materials, invested in technology software, and assessment programs. Help us continue to offer these opportunities for our students.

To make a contribution, complete the form on this letter and accompany it with a check made out to Kingman Unified School District to the school of your choice. Donations may be made in one lump sum or through small installments. The school will provide you with a receipt for use in your tax preparations. Please share this opportunity with your friends and family. You are urged to make your contribution by noon on December 21st at any school or before December 31st at the KUSD district office (3033 MacDonald Avenue 753-5678) for credit on this year's taxes.

Unfortunately, there is no guarantee that this tax credit opportunity will be available next year. If you have specific questions on Arizona's tax credit law, please contact your tax preparer.

Tax Credit Program

Take the credit . . . it is easy!

Make your check payable to KUSD #20, complete the form in this brochure, and return both to the school you are contributing to or the District Office. The staff will send you a receipt verifying that you have contributed to an eligible extra-curricular activity. Then, using AZ Form 140, with attachments 301 & 322, all you have to do is take the credit on your Arizona tax return.

Although you may donate any amount, the tax credit can only be applied for contributions up to \$400.00 for married couples or \$200.00 for single persons. The tax credit can be claimed on personal income tax returns only. Contributions from businesses are welcome. Such contributions are deductible, but cannot be used to claim a tax return.

Anyone can take the credit!

Good news! You don't have to be parents of school children to earn the credit! Arizona tax law A.R.S. 43-1089.01 applies to **all** taxpayers, regardless of whether or not they have children in school. This tax law is a tax **credit**. It is **subtracted** from the taxes you owe and is a refund of the amount donated (up to \$400.00 for married couples, \$200.00 for single persons).

Your donations go where you say!

Contributions that are eligible for the tax credit donations go directly to the school(s) and program(s) that you designate. There are no overhead or administrative fees at the district or state levels. These funds go directly to help student programs.

Your credit, your choice!

To claim the Arizona Tax Credit, simply donate to an activity or academic program that requires a fee. You may contribute to one of the general categories listed below, or you may specify a program you want to support – all for the school and program of your choice!
